

7) Allowing Your Computer to Run Too Many Start-up Processes

Having a great deal of start-up processes running as soon as your computer boots up will really slow things down.

To fix this, go to the start-up tab or start-up items and disable anything you don't need. Your computer will start up and run faster as a result.

Windows 8, 8.1, and 10 make it really simple to disable start-up applications. All you have to do is open up Task Manager by right-clicking on the Taskbar



or using the CTRL + SHIFT + ESC shortcut key, pressing "Task Manager", clicking "More Details," switching to the Startup tab, and then using the Disable button.



It's really that simple. If you aren't seeing these options, make sure to click "More Details," which is in the same place as the "Fewer details" that you see on the screenshot above.

6) Inserting Your USB Upside Down & Continually Trying to Push It In

Aggressively pushing your USB into the USB-port can easily cause damage to the port and prevent you from being able to use a portable drive whatsoever.

Make sure to line up the USB stick with the port before slotting it inside.

5) Not Blocking Popups

Do you have popups relentlessly cluttering up your desktop? They will also slow down your browser and may allow a third party to mine your personal information.

To stop this from happening, you can install a web browser extension that blocks these annoying popups from appearing. However, when looking for an extension to download make sure it's legitimate.



One way to do so is to find online reviews from a third-party source or seek a recommendation from your local computer technician.

4) Not Giving Your Computer Space to Breathe

If your computer is on carpet or up against a wall it can cause heat to build up and if it can't dissipate, it can damage the hard drive and other components.

Laptops are also often left sitting on beds or couches which blocks the vents.

Make sure your computer or laptop has space to breathe and also remember to vacuum around your computer when it's stored under a desk to remove dust and avoid a build up from happening.

3) Not Installing Your Latest System Updates

Foregoing system updates can introduce a level of potential instability, and can leave your computer open and vulnerable to attack from a hacker or malware which can cause serious damage to your data and potential for identity theft.

When your operating system recommends an update, make sure to complete the update as soon as possible.



2) Not Backing Up Your Important Files

Remember these aren't just files being lost, they could be precious memories and critical personal information that you can't afford to use.


